REGULATIONS IN TERMS OF THE COUNCIL FOR THE BUILT ENVIRONMENT ACT, 2000

The Minister of Public Works has in terms of section 22 of the Council for the Built Environment Act, 2000 (Act No. 43 of 2000) made the regulations set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

Definitions

1. In these regulations any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall be the meaning so assign to it and, unless the context otherwise indicates-

"the Act" means the Council for the Built Environment Act, 2000 (Act No. 43 of 2000);

"council" means the Council for the Built Environment established in terms of section 2 of the Act;

Application

2. The procedure set out in this Schedule applies when the appointment of a chairperson or deputy chairperson becomes necessary in terms of sections 9(1) or 9(5).

Appointment chairperson and deputy chair person

- 3. When the appointment of a chairperson and a deputy chairperson is necessary in terms of section 9(1), the Minister will appoint such person from the members of the newly constituted council.
- 4. If the appointment of a chairperson or a deputy chairperson is necessary in terms of section 9(5), the Minister will appoint such person from the members of the Council as chairperson or deputy chairperson.
- 5. The person appointed by the Minister as chairperson or deputy chairperson must, when accepting the appointment, do so in writing.
- 6. The Minister or his or her representative will announce the names of the chairperson and the deputy chairperson appointed in terms of section 9(1) at the first meeting of each newly constituted council.

7. The Minister or his or her representative will announce the name of the chairperson or the deputy chairperson appointed in terms of section 9(5) at the first meeting following such appointment.

Appointment Criteria

- 8. The Minister must appoint a chairperson or a deputy chairperson who, in the opinion of the Minister,
 - (1) is able to provide strategic leadership to council;
 - (2) has experience and expertise in matters pertaining to the built environment and its development objectives;
 - (3) has experience and expertise in financial management and corporate governance; and
 - (4) is able to promote the national and socio-economic imperatives.

Short title and commencement

9. These regulations are called the Regulations Relating to the Council for the Built Environment Act, 2010.
