VETERINARY AND PARA-VETERINARY PROFESSIONS ACT, 1982 (ACT No. 19 OF 1982)

REGULATIONS RELATING TO VETERINARY AND PARA-VETINARY PROFESSIONS: AMENDMENT

The Minister of Agriculture has under section 43 of the Veterinary and Para-Veterinary Professions Act, 1982 (Act No. 19 of 1982), made the regulations in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Insertion of Regulation 19 D

1. The Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion of the following heading and regulation after regulation 19 C:

"Lecturers: Veterinarians

19 D. Any lecturer involved with hands –on training in clinical work must be registered as a veterinary professional or authorised by Council to perform the services that pertain specially to the veterinary profession."

Insertion of Regulation 21 J

2. The Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion of the following heading and regulation after regulation 21 I:

"Lecturers: Para-Veterinary professions

21 J. Any lecturer involved with hands –on training in clinical work must be registered as a veterinary professional or as a para-veterinary professional or authorised by Council to perform the services that pertain specially to the veterinary or para-veterinary profession profession."

Amendment of Table 7- of the Regulations

3. Table 7 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion of the following entry after B.
