- - (b) The issuing of an unabridged birth or death certificate, a reproduction of the relevant register or a reproduction of any supporting documentation which is coupled to the register concerned, as well as verification of information from a birth and death register with regard to any individual: Provided that where such reproduction or verification is required for official purposes by a Government

- An application to assume a different surname as contemplated in (f) section 26 of the Act: Provided that, should the applicant be lawfully married at the time of the application, the fee shall include the application of his or her spouse, and those of any minor children, or if the applicant is divorced, a widow or a widower, the fee shall also include the of his if application or her minor, any)......R325-00
- (h) No fee is payable for the furnishing of information for official purposes to any State Department, local authority or statutory body as contemplated in section 29(2) of the Act. However, the fees determined for abridged and unabridged birth certificates shall be payable if such certificates are requested.
