RULES RELATING TO THE REGISTRATION BY BIOKINETICISTS OF ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

The Health Professions Council of South Africa has, under Section 61A (1) (L) read with Section 35 of the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act No. 56 of 1974), made the rules in the schedule.

SCHEDULE

Definitions

1. In these rules "the Act" means the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act No.56 of 1974) and any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall have that meaning, and unless the context otherwise indicates:-

"board" means the Professional Board for Physiotherapy, Podiatry and Biokinetics established under section 15 of the Act;

"biokineticist" means a person registered as such under the Act.

2. The following qualifications obtained by biokineticists in the field of biokinetics, unless otherwise specified, shall be registrable as additional qualifications under section 35 of the Act:-
