SCHEDULE

Definitions

 In these rules "the Act" means the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act No. 56 of 1974) and any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall have that meaning, and unless the context otherwise indicates:-

"board" means the Professional Board for Dental Therapy and Oral Hygiene established in terms of section 15 of the Act;

"Oral Hygienist" means a person registered as such in terms of the Act.

2. The following qualifications held by Oral Hygienists shall, in terms of section 35 of the Act, be registrable as additional qualifications:

Examining authority and qualification

Abbreviation for registration

University of the Witwatersrand

Diploma in Health Service Management

DHSM Witwatersrand

University of the Western Cape

Magister Scientiae Dentium

(MSc. Dentium)
