#### **BOARD NOTICE 150 OF 2010**

### THE SOUTH AFRICAN PHARMACY COUNCIL

### FEES PAYABLE TO THE COUNCIL UNDER THE PHARMACY ACT 53 OF 1974

In terms of section 4(zG) of the Pharmacy Act 53 of 1974, as amended, Council may determine the fees payable to Council, without publication thereof in regulations. In practice, this would mean that any new fees or amendments to existing fees will be determined annually by Council. As in the past, all efforts will be made to curtail costs and keep any increases in fees to the minimum. The fees for 2011 are published below for general information:
