

BOARD NOTICE 178 OF 2010**DEFINING OF PRODUCTION AREA: BREEDE RIVER VALLEY (AMENDMENT)**

The Wine and Spirit Board, acting under section 6 of the Wine of Origin Scheme published by Government Notice No. R. 1434 of 29 June 1990 hereby –

- (a) defines the area specified in the Schedule as a production area (region) under the name Breede River Valley and
- (b) repeals herewith Government Notice No R 2415 of 27 December 1974 and Board Notice No 79 of 29 August 1997.

SCHEDULE**DEFINING OF THE PRODUCTION AREA BREEDE RIVER VALLEY**

- (i) That portion of the former divisional council area of Tulbagh south of an imaginary direct line drawn to connect the most south-easterly beacon of the land known as "Kasteels Kloof" on the boundary between the divisional council areas of Tulbagh and Paarl, with the most south-easterly beacon of the land known as "Dixon's Berg" on the boundary between the divisional council of Tulbagh and Ceres, through the township area of Wolseley.
- (ii) That portion of the former divisional council area of Worcester with exclusion of the land known as Remainder portion and Portion 1 of the farm Achter Rooihogte 581, Worcester and Portions 1 and 17 of the farm Ratelfontein 582, Worcester.
- (iii) The former divisional council area of Robertson.
- (iv) That portion of the former divisional council area of Swellendam which are included in the defined production area of Robertson.
