AMENDMENT OF THE GOVERNMENT NOTICE FOR THE COMPULSORY SPECIFICATION FOR COMPACT FLUORESCENT LAMPS, CFL's, (VC 9091)

It is hereby made known under section 13(2) (c) of the National Regulator for Compulsory Specifications Act, (Act 5 of 2008), that the Minister of Trade and Industry, on the recommendation of the NRCS Board, amends the effective date of the compulsory specification for *Compact Fluorescent Lamps*, as published under Government Notice No. 348(Government Gazette 33152) of 7 May 2010.

The effective date is amended as follows:

- 1. All requirements for Safety and Performance, excluding the life-spent requirement would be effective from 1 February 2011.
- 2. Requirements for Type 5 Product Certification Scheme would be effective from 1 August 2011.
- 3. Requirements for Performance i.e. life spent requirements would be effective from 1 August 2011.
