SOUTH AFRICAN PASSPORTS AND TRAVEL DOCUMENTS ACT, 1994

SEVENTEENTH AMENDMENT OF THE REGULATIONS MADE UNDER THE SOUTH AFRICAN PASSPORTS AND TRAVEL DOCUMENTS ACT, 1994

The Minister of Home Affairs has, in consultation with the Minister of Finance, under section 4(1)(e) of the South African Passports and Travel Documents Act, 1994 (Act No. 4 of 1994), hereinafter referred to as "the Act", made the regulations in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Definition

1. In this Schedule "the Regulations" means the Regulations made under section 4(1)(e) of the South African Passports and Travel Documents Act, 1994 (Act No. 4 of 1994), published under Government Notice No. R. 784 of 10 May 1996, as amended by Government Notice Nos. R. 1027 of 21 June 1996, R. 580 of 11 April 1997, R. 1564 of 21 November 1997, R. 353 of 13 March 1998, R. 384 of 24 March 1999, R. 251 of 17 March 2000, R. 314 of 30 March 2001, R. 409 of 28 March 2002, R. 1495 of 2 December 2002, R. 476 of 31 March 2003, R. 430 of 31 March 2004, R. 319 of 1 April 2005, R. 473 of 19 May 2006, R. 68 of 28 January 2008, R. 346 of 27 March 2009 and R. 1000 of 29 October 2010.

Amendment of regulation 16 of the Regulations

- 2. Regulation 16 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for subregulation (1) of the following subregulation:
 - "16.(1) Subject to subregulations (2) and (3), the fees payable in respect of the issue of a South African passport or travel document under the Act shall be as follows:

(a)	South African passport: 32 pages	R400-00;
(b)	South African passport: 48 pages	R600-00;
(c)	Child passport	R400-00;
(d)	Document for travel purposes	R300-00;
(e)	Emergency passport	R140-00;
<i>(f)</i>	Temporary passport	R180-00;
(g)	Crew member certificate	R350.00.".

Short title and commencement

3. These Regulations shall be called the Seventeenth Amendment of the Regulations made under the South African Passports and Travel Documents Act, 1994, and shall come into operation on 1 April 2011.
