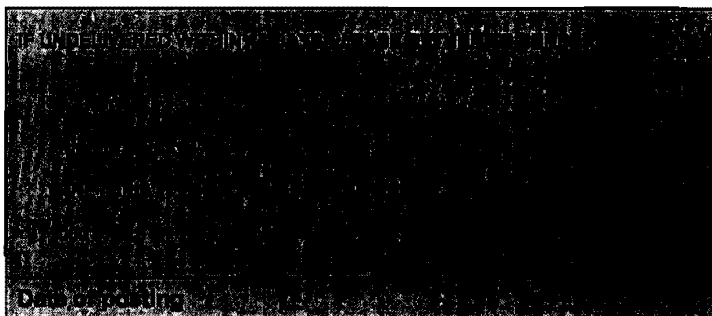

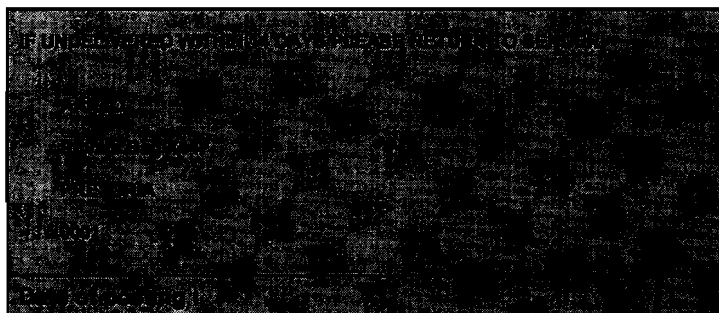

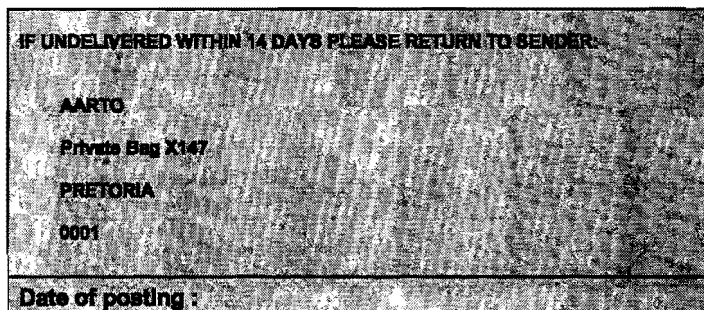

This Warrant may be executed by any sheriff appointed in terms of section 12 of Act No 46 of 1998 or the Sheriff's Act No 90 of 1986 and empowered to execute a Warrant.

1. You are hereby ordered by the Registrar of the Road Traffic Infringement Agency to execute the terms set out in this Warrant, between 07h00 and 21h00, on the person referred to as the infringer on the reverse side hereof.
2. The result of the execution must be reported to the Agency.
3. Whereas the said infringer failed to comply with the requirements of the Infringement Notice, Courtesy Letter and Enforcement Order served on him or her in terms of the Act; and
