NOTIFICATION BY PRESIDENT IN RESPECT OF ENTITIES IDENTIFIED THE UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL: BY SECTION OF THE PROTECTION OF CONSTITUTIONAL 25 DEMOCRACY AGAINST TERRORIST AND RELATED ACTIVITIES ACT. 2004

I, Jacob Gedleyihiekisa Zuma, President of the Republic of South Africa, hereby, in terms of section 25 of the Protection of Constitutional Democracy against Terrorist and Related Activities Act, 2004 (Act No. 33 of 2004), give notice that the Security Council of the United Nations, under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations, has amended the information reflected in the Annexure in respect of entities which have been identified as being -

- (a) an entity who commit, or attempt to commit, any terrorist and related activity or participate in or facilitates the commission of any terrorist and related activity; or
- (b) an entity against whom Member States of the United Nations must take the actions specified in the Resolutions of the said Security Council, in order to combat or prevent terrorist and related activities.
