

**NOTICE 138 OF 2012****NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTION 62(7) OF THE LABOUR RELATIONS ACT, NO 66 OF 1995**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT:-

1. The South African Transport and Allied Workers' Union (SATAWU) has applied to the Commission for Conciliation, Mediation and Arbitration (the CCMA) in terms of section 62(1) of the Labour Relations Act of 1995 for a demarcation to effect that the operations of MSC Logistics fall within the scope of the National Bargaining Council for the Road Freight Industry

2. It is alleged that MSC Logistics provides support services to MSC Depots (Pty) Ltd in that its workers clean and repair the containers.
