SCHEDULE 2

The regulation document, *Regulations pertaining to the Conduct, Administration and Management of Assessment for the National Senior Certificate*, published as *Regulation Notice*, *No. R872* in *Government Gazette No. 31337* of 29 August 2008 is hereby amended by the following:

Amendment of Regulation 7

- Regulation 7 is hereby amended by the substitution of sub-regulation (5) for the following sub-regulation-
 - "7(5) The School-Based Assessment, Practical Assessment Task (PAT), Practical Assessment and Oral marks obtained by a candidate in his or her last National Senior Certificate examinations will be valid for a period of [two (2)] five (5) years after the completion of the first National Senior Certificate examinations written by the candidate."

Short title and commencement

2. This Regulation document called "Regulations pertaining to the Conduct, Administration and Management of Assessment for the National Senior Certificate", and will come into effect on the date of publication in the Government Gazette.
