#### DRAFT INVITATION TO APPLY

#### FOR

#### RADIO FREQUENCY SPECTRUM LICENCE

#### TO PROVIDE MOBILE BROADBAND WIRELESS ACCESS SERVICE FOR URBAN AND RURAL AREAS USING THE COMPLIMENTARY BANDS, 800MHz AND 2.6GHz

The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority"), subsequent to the erratum notice number 44 of 2012, published in Government Gazette No. 34961, hereby issues a revised time table to be inserted in notice number 912, Government Gazette Number 34872 published on 15 December 2011.

The Authority published a draft spectrum assignment plan together with the ITA on combined licensing of 800 MHz and 2.6 GHz bands for broadband wireless access services. This was done in terms of section 31(3) of the Electronic Communications Act, 2005 (Act No. 36 of 2005) ("the Act") read with Regulation 7 of the Radio Frequency Spectrum Regulations 2011, published in Government Gazette No. 34172, Notice 184 of 2011 (the regulations).

The authority hereby postpones the process until further notice.
