

**HIGHER EDUCATION ACT, 1997, (ACT NO 101 OF 1997)****AMENDMENT TO THE STATUTE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CAPE TOWN**

The Council of the University of Cape Town has made the changes set out in the schedule to the Statute of the University in accordance with section 32 of the Act, with the approval of the Minister of Higher Education & Training, and which comes into effect on the date of publication.

**SCHEDULE**

*General explanatory note:*

[ ] words in bold type in square brackets indicate deletions from the existing statute.

\_\_\_\_\_ words underlined with a solid line indicate additions to the existing statute.

1. In this schedule the expression “the Statute” means the Statute of the University of Cape Town as published under Government Notice No 1199 of 20 September 2002 and as subsequently amended by Government Notices 259 of 26 February 2004 476 of 20 May 2005 and 542 of 27 August 2010.
  2. Paragraph 44(2) of the Statute is hereby amended as follows:  
  
“(2) The SRC consists of between fifteen and twenty students as prescribed by the SRC constitution elected in a general election in the second term of each year in which every student who has been registered for at least one term is entitled to vote.
  3. Paragraph 50(3)(a) of the Statute is hereby amended as follows:-  
  
“(a) all voting on a proposal in either body must be by secret ballot, and voting on a Proposal in senate must be by secret postal ballot;”
