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

N.B The current wage increases have been determined by utilizing the CPI (excluding owners' equivalent rent) reported by Stats SA on 23 May 2012. The current level of CPI is 6,4%. The wage increase is therefore determined by adding 6,4% plus 1% as stated in the current Sectoral Determination. Therefore the total increase is 7,4%

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
