NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY ACT, 1996 (ACT NO. 27 OF 1996)

APPROVAL OF THE AMENDED CURRICULUM AND ASSESSMENT POLICY STATEMENT FOR NATURAL SCIENCES AND TECHNOLOGY IN THE INTERMEDIATE PHASE (GRADES 4-6) AS NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY

- I, Angelina Matsie Motshekga, Minister of Basic Education, hereby, in terms of sections 3(4)(I) and 7 of the National Education Policy Act, 1996 (Act No. 27 of 1996), and after consultation with the Council of Education Ministers, approve the amended Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statement of the subject, Natural Sciences and Technology in the Intermediate Phase (Grades 4-6) as national education policy.
- 2. The Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statement of the new subject, Natural Sciences and Technology in the Intermediate Phase (Grades 4-6) was published for public comment in *Government Gazette No.333528* of 3 September 2010 and the approval thereof for listing in the *National Curriculum Statement Grades R-12* was published in *Government Gazette No. 34600* of 12 September 2011.
- 3. The amendments to the Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statement of the new independent subject, Natural Sciences and Technology in the Intermediate Phase (Grades 4-6) have been approved by me and will be implemented in the Intermediate Phase (Grades 4-6) for the first time in January 2013.
- The status quo as stipulated in the policy document, General Education Programmes: The Revised National Curriculum Statement Grades R – 9 (Schools), namely the offering of Natural Sciences and Technology as two independent subjects will be maintained in Grade 4-6 in 2012.
