SMALL CLAIMS COURTS ACT, 1984 (ACT NO. 61 OF 1984)

ESTABLISHMENT OF SMALL CLAIMS COURTS FOR THE AREAS OF DUNDEE AND GLENCOE AND WITHDRAWAL OF GOVERNMENT NOTICE NO. 549 OF 31 MARCH 1989

- I, Andries Carl Nel, Deputy Minister of Justice and Constitutional Development, acting under the power delegated to me by the Minister of Justice and Constitutional Development, under section 2 of the Small Claims Courts Act, 1984 (Act No. 61 of 1984), hereby -
 - (a) (i) establish a Small Claims Court for the adjudication of claims for the area of Dundee, consisting of the districts of Dundee and Dannhauser;
 - (ii) determine Dundee to be the seat of the said Court; and
 - (iii) determine Dundee and Dannhauser to be the places in that area for the holding of sessions of the said Court.
 - (b) (i) establish a Small Claims Court for the adjudication of claims for the area of Glencoe, consisting of the district of Glencoe;
 - (ii) determine Glencoe to be the seat of the said Court; and
 - (iii) determine Glencoe to be the place in that area for the holding of sessions of the said Court.
 - (c) withdraw Government Notice No. 549 of 31 March 1989.

Despite the withdrawal of Government Notice No. 549 of 31 March 1989, any claim emanating from the district of Glencoe which has already been instituted in the Small Claims Court of Dundee prior to the publication of this Government Notice, shall be continued and concluded in the Small Claims Court of Dundee as if this Government Notice has not been published.
