FINANCIAL ADVISORY AND INTERMEDIARY SERVICES ACT, 2002

EXEMPTION OF ANNE CABOT-ALLETZHAUSER FROM THE QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

I, German Emmanuel Anderson, Deputy Registrar of Financial Services Providers, hereby exempt under section 44(4) of the Financial Advisory and Intermediary Services Act, 2002, Anne Cabot-Alletzhauser from provisions of the Act and certain measures promulgated thereunder, to the extent set out in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

EXEMPTION OF ANNE CABOT-ALLETZHAUSER FROM THE QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Definitions

1. In this Schedule, "the Act" means the Financial Advisory and Intermediary Services Act, 2002, any word or expression to which a meaning is assigned in the Act shall have that meaning, and unless the context otherwise indicates-

"Determination of Fit and Proper Requirements" means the Determination of Fit and Proper Requirements for Financial Services Providers, 2008.

"qualification requirements" means the applicable-

- (a) qualification requirement referred to in Column Two of Table E of the Determination of Fit and Proper Requirements; or
- (b) requirement to complete a qualification from the list of recognised qualifications.

Extent, duration and conditions of Exemption

- 2. Anne Cabot-Alletzhauser is exempted from paragraphs 5 and 10 of the Determination of Fit and Proper Requirements insofar it relates to the qualification requirements, subject to the conditions that she must-
 - (a) remain a member of the CFA Institute and the CFA Society South Africa; and
 - (b) advise immediately the Registrar of any change to the particulars furnished in her exemption application.

Amendment and withdrawal of Exemption

- 3. This Exemption is subject to-
 - (a) amendment thereof published by the registrar by notice in the Gazette; and
 - (b) withdrawal in like manner.

Short title and commencement

4. This Exemption is called the Exemption of Anne Cabot-Alletzhauser from the Qualification Requirements, 2012, and comes into operation on the date of publication in the *Gazette*.
