I, Pravin J Gordhan, Minister of Finance, acting in terms of sections 15(2) and 25(2) of the Division of Revenue Act, 2012 (Act No. 5 of 2012), as amended by the Division of Revenue Amendment Act, 2012 (Act No. 18 of 2012), hereby publish in the attached Explanatory Memorandum and Schedules -

- (a) additional conditional allocations to provinces and municipalities authorised in terms of the Adjustments Appropriation Act, 2012;
- (b) roll-overs of conditional allocations to provinces and municipalities not transferred by national departments during the 2011/12 financial year, authorised in terms of the Adjustments Appropriation Act, 2012;
- (d) the allocation of unallocated conditional grants to provinces and municipalities;
- (e) the re-allocation of stopped conditional allocations between municipalities in terms of section 19 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2012, as amended;
- (f) technical adjustments on conditional allocations to provinces and municipalities; and
- (g) additional and amended frameworks in respect of conditional allocations to provinces and municipalities.

For ease of reference only and where applicable, the attached Schedules reflect the main allocations, roll-overs, adjustments and total adjusted allocations.

This Government Notice is set out as follows:

- Part 1: conditional allocations to municipalities; and
- Part 2: Additional and amended frameworks for conditional allocations to provinces and municipalities.

## **Explanatory Memorandum to the Allocations set out in the attached Schedules**

This *Gazette* is published in terms of the Division of Revenue Act, 2012 (Act No. 5 of 2012), as amended by the Division of Revenue Amendment Act, 2012 (Act No. 18 of 2012) and provides information on additional allocations and adjustments to existing allocations to provinces and municipalities in the 2012/13 national financial year.

This is necessitated by the need to allocate additional funds to provinces and municipalities, as approved in terms of the Adjustments Appropriation Act, 2012 (Act No. 17 of 2012) and effected by the Division of Revenue Amendment Act, 2012. It is also necessitated by the need to allocate unallocated allocations to provinces and municipalities, and the re-allocation of funds in terms of Section 19 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2012, as amended.

This *Gazette* therefore updates information that was originally published in Government Gazettes No. 35361 of 17 May 2012 and No. 35399 of 31 May 2012.

This notice affects the following grant programmes:

### ***Provincial allocations***

#### *Adjustments to conditional grants*

A new conditional grant will be established as a once-off allocation to provinces for the provision of health and medical services for the 2013 Africa Cup of Nations (AFCON) scheduled from 18 January to 10 February 2013, and all related official events. An amount of R15 million is allocated to five provinces and the framework for the grant is gazetted here.

#### *Correction to the Expanded Public Works Programme Integrated grant provincial departmental allocation in the Northern Cape*

The Government Gazette (No. 35399, dated 31 May 2012) published in terms of section 15(1) of the 2012 Division of Revenue Act (Act No.5 of 2012) incorrectly allocated R1 million for the EPWP Integrated grant to the department of Economic Development and Tourism instead of the department of Environment and Nature Conservation in the Northern Cape province. Until April 2010, both the departments were under the Northern Cape department of Tourism, Environment and Conservation and the misallocation occurred when the departments were split. The attached Appendix 1 has been amended to reflect the correct EPWP Integrated grant allocation for the department of Environment and Nature Conservation in the 2012/13 financial year.

### ***Local government allocations***

#### *Re-allocation of funds between municipalities*

- a. The Neighbourhood Development Partnership Grant is being re-allocated to other municipalities due to non-performance of the grant allocation. These funds will be re-allocated to municipalities that have fast tracked the implementation of the projects and have accelerated expenditure against the original allocation.
- b. The national Department of Energy is re-allocating funds between municipalities, under the Integrated National Electrification Programme (INEP 6) and Electricity

Demand Side Management Grant (EDSM 6). Slow spending and delays in contractual agreements, poor business plans and non compliance by municipalities are the main reasons for the decision to re-allocate between municipalities.

- c. The Public Transport Infrastructure Grant is being re-allocated to Rustenburg Local Municipality which has accelerated expenditure against its allocation. The main reason for re-allocation is due to municipalities indicating that they would not be able to spend their full or portion of the allocation for the 2012/13 financial year.
- d. The Infrastructure Skills Development Grant is also being re-allocated between municipalities because of the anticipated under-spending on the programme. Funds are being re-allocated to other municipalities that can spend.
- e. An amount of R45.5 million was added to Expanded Public Works Programme Integrated Grant to provide for the full incentive amounts earned by municipalities in the third and fourth quarters of the 2011/12 municipal financial year.
- f. An amount of R13.6 million was declared as savings by the Department of Water Affairs for the Regional Bulk Infrastructure Grant for projects that are expected to under-spend.
- g. The Department of Human Settlement also declared a savings for an amount of R138.9 million for the Rural Households Infrastructure Grant and reallocated to other government priorities. These funds will be returned to the National Revenue Fund during the 2012 Adjustment Budget. These savings comes from allocations that had been earmarked for specific municipalities.

#### *Roll-over of funds*

- h. Regional Bulk Infrastructure Grant: A roll-over of R20 million was approved as a result of funds committed to projects in 2011/12. This is an indirect grant through which is used by the the national Department of Water Affairs builds bulk water supply systems that cross municipal boundaries on behalf of municipalities.
- i. Expanded Public Works Programme Integrated Grant: A roll-over of R17.4 million was approved as the result of funds earned by municipalities not being transferred during 2011/12. These funds were not transferred on time as a result of technical problems with the payment system. This roll-over ensures that municipalities receive the full incentive amounts that they earned for their performance in creating employment.

#### *Correction of error made on the original allocation*

- j. In the 2012 Division of Revenue Act, funds were allocated incorrectly for two KwaZulu-Natal municipalities as a result of a technical error, and a correction was done through the Adjustment Bill. An amount of R11.9 million was allocated to Hlabisa Local Municipality instead of R21.9 million and Mtubatuba Local Municipality was allocated with R20.9 million instead of R10.9 million for the Municipal Infrastructure Grant in the 2012/13 financial year. The correction was effected without altering the baseline of the Municipal infrastructure Grant.

*Unallocated funds*

- k. An amount of R43.5 million is scheduled to be transferred from an unallocated Municipal Disaster Grant amounting to R330 million. The funds will be allocated to six Eastern Cape municipalities to repair water pumps, sewerage pumps, electrical infrastructure and provide temporary access roads and bridges where infrastructure was damaged by heavy floods and rain.

*New conditional grant*

- l. An adjustment to provide cities with an operational grant for hosting the 2013 Africa Cup of Nations (AFCON) championship has been introduced. The grant will have conditions similar to those of the 2010 FIFA World Cup host cities operating grant.
