COMPENSATION FOR OCCUPATIONAL INJURIES AND DISEASES ACT, 1993 (ACT No. 130 OF 1993), AS AMENDED

TO INCREASE THE MONTHLY PENSIONS OF INJURED MPLOYEES AND DEPENDANTS IN CASE OF DEATH (WIDOWS/WIDOWERS) WHO ARE CURRENTLY RECEIVING A MONTHLY PENSION OF LESS THAN R1 000.00 PER MONTH, TO A MINIMUM PENSION OF R1 000.00 PER MONTH.

Under section 57(1) of the Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act, 1993 (Act No 130 of 1993), I, Mildred Nelisiwe Oliphant, Minister of Labour, hereby prescribe a minimum level of pension on Compensation fund with immediate effect to the following beneficiaries:

Monthly pensions of injured employees, irrespective of their level of disablement, currently receiving a monthly pension of less than a R1 000.00 per month to a minimum amount of R1 000.00 per month.

Monthly pension of dependants (widows/widowers) currently receiving less than R1 000.00 per month to a minimum of R1 000.00 per month.

Pensioners or dependants who commuted a portion of their pensions should not be eligible, and their pensions should not be adjusted as above.
