Explanatory Memorandum to the Provincial Allocations set out in the Schedule

This *Gazette* is published in terms of the Division of Revenue Act, 2012 (Act No. 5 of 2012), as amended by the Division of Revenue Amendment Act, 2012 (Act No. 18 of 2012), and provides information on adjustments to existing allocations to provinces in the 2012/13 financial year.

This is necessitated by the need to stop the flow of funds in terms of Section 18 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2012, as amended, and the need to re-allocate the stopped funds to provinces, as approved in terms of Section 19 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2012, as amended.

This *Gazette* therefore updates information that was published in the Division of Revenue Amendment Act, 2012.

This notice affects the Devolution of Property Rate Funds grant and the Mass Participation and Sport Development grant:

- a) In compliance with Section 18 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2012, as amended, the national Department of Public Works stops the transfer of funds to KwaZulu-Natal to the value of R120.5 million for the Devolution of Property Rate Funds grant, following slow spending on the part of KwaZulu-Natal.
 - b) In compliance with Section 19 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2012, as amended, the national Department of Public Works re-allocates funds to the Free State to the value of R36.6 million, Mpumalanga to the value of R28.3 million and Western Cape to the value of R44.5 million for the Devolution of Property Rate Funds grant, following demonstrated capacity to spend in the Free State, Mpumalanga and Western Cape.
 - c) In compliance with Section 18 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2012, as amended, the national Department of Sport and Recreation South Africa stops the transfer of funds to Eastern Cape (R0.584 million), Free State (R0.255 million), Gauteng (R0.582 million), KwaZulu-Natal (R0.574 million), Limpopo (R0.031 million), Mpumalanga (R0.198 million), North West (R0.233 million) and Western Cape (R0.148 million) for the Mass Participation and Sport Development grant, following revised allocations by the national Department of Sport and Recreation South Africa.
 - d) In compliance with Section 19 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2012, as amended, the national Department of Sport and Recreation South Africa re-allocates funds to Northern Cape to the value of R2.6 million for the Mass Participation and Sport Development grant, following revised allocations by the national Department of Sport and Recreation South Africa.
