Definition

1. In this Schedule "the Rules" means the Rules Regulating the Conduct of the Proceedings of the Magistrates' Courts of South Africa published under Government Notice No. R. 740 of 23 August 2010, as amended by Government Notice Nos. R. 1222 of 24 December 2010, R. 611 of 29 July 2011, R.1085 of 30 December 2011, R. 685 of 31 August 2012 and R. 115 of 15 February 2013.

Amendment of rule 58 of the Rules

- **2.** Rule 58 of the Rules is hereby amended by the substitution for sub-rules (7) and (8) of the following sub-rules:
- "(7) No <u>attorney or</u> advocate appearing in a case under this rule shall charge a fee of more than **[R175.00]** R404,00 if the claim is undefended or **[R250.00]** R929,00 if it is defended, unless the court in an exceptional case otherwise directs.
- (8) No instructing attorney in cases under this rule shall charge a fee of more than **[R250.00]** R1 414,00 if the claim is undefended or **[R375.00]** R2 020,00 if it is defended, unless the court in an exceptional case otherwise directs."
