SCHEDULE

The policy document, *National policy pertaining to the programme and promotion requirements of the National Curriculum Statement Grades R – 12, Government Notices No. 722 and No. 723, in Government Gazette No. 34600 of 12 September 2011*, is hereby amended by the following-

Amendment of Paragraph 35 of the Policy document

1. *Paragraph 29* is hereby amended by the substitution for sub-paragraph (1)(c)(ii) of the following sub-paragraph-
“(1)(c)(ii) Trinity College of London Practical Music Examination Grade 7: at least [**65%**] 60%.”.

Short title and commencement

2. This Policy is called *"National policy pertaining to the programme and promotion requirements of the National Curriculum Statement Grades R – 12"*, and will come into effect on the date of publication in the *Government Gazette*.
