#### DRAFT NATIONAL FORESTS AMENDMENT BILL, 2013

#### INVITATION FOR PUBLIC COMMENTS

I, Tina Joemat-Pettersson, Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries hereby invite all interested institutions, organizations and individuals to submit written comments on the draft National Forests Amendment Bill.

Some of the Key amendments of the National Forests Amendment Bill include:

- Clear definition of Natural forests and Woodlands
- Increased promotion and enforcement of Sustainable Forest Management
- Reduce cost for compliance promotion in terms of section 15 ( for example currently the Act requires the National list of Protected trees to be published annually, with the proposed amendment the list will be the published at least every 5 years or when the need arises before the 5 year period end)
- Increase in measures to control and remedy deforestation
- Clear procedures for making regulations.
