BOARD NOTICE 145 OF 2013 DEFINING OF PRODUCTION AREA: ST HELENA BAY

defines the area specified in the Schedule as a production area (ward) under the name St Helena Bay.

SCHEDULE

DEFINING OF PRODUCTION AREA: ST HELENA BAY

That area situate within the following boundaries:

Start at the north-western beacon of Verloren Vlei 8, in the vicinity of Baboon Point and the Bobbejaansberg; thence generally south with the general northern boundaries of said Verloren Vlei 8, the quartanary catchment area G30A and a series of high-lying hills/tops named Houthoekkop, Mierberg, Klein Tafelberg and Dassieberg to a point where it joins the most eastern beacon of Klipfontein 21, in the vicinity of Tierneskop; thence further south with a portion of the south-eastern boundary of said Klipfontein 21 and the eastern and southern boundaries of Rietfontein 18 to the south-western beacon thereof; thence south-west with the south-eastern boundary of Papkuilsfontein 35 to the southern beacon thereof; thence further south-west with an imaginary straight line, drawn from the southern beacon of said Papkuilsfontein 35 to the north-eastern beacon of farm 90; thence generally north-west with the northern boundary of said farm 90 and the southern boundary of Oliphants Kraal 61 to the south beacon of Patrysenberg 44; thence further north-west with the general western

boundaries of said Patrysenberg 44, Lange Klip 47, Blaauwberg 44, Blaauwberg 1201, Soldatenpost 20 and the north-eastern boundary of Davids Fontyn 18 to the northern beacon thereof; thence north-east with the south-eastern boundary of Duyker Eiland 6 to the north-eastern beacon thereof; thence further north-east with an imaginary straight line to where it joins the Atlantic ocean; thence generally north with the coastline to where it joins the north-western beacon of Verloren Vlei 8, in the vicinity of Baboon Point and the Bobbejaansberg, the beginning mentioned above.
