**Nature of Offence:**

**Guilty** of contravention of Rules 3(1)(c) of the Rules of Conduct for Registered Persons promulgated under Board Notice 15, of 2006 Government Gazette number 28605 of 17 March 2006

**Sanction:**

1. Respondent is fined R20 000 (Twenty Thousand Rand) in terms of the provisions of section 32(3)(a)(ii) of the Act, of which R10 000 (Ten Thousand Rand) is suspended for a period of 3 (Three) years on the following conditions:

- 1.1 That the RESPONDENT is not found guilty of the contravention of Rule), 3(1)(c) of the Rules of Conduct for Registered Persons, committed during the period of suspension.
- 1.2 That the RESPONDENT shall, before the end of 2013, at his own expense, attend a seminar course approved by ECSA, which relates to Engineering Ethics.
