DEPARTMENT OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT AND LAND REFORM: RESTITUTION OF LAND RIGHTS AMENDMENT BILL, 2013

The Minister for Rural Development and Land Reform intends introducing the Restitution of Land Rights Amendment Bill, 2013 in the National Assembly during the third quarter of 2013. The explanatory summary of the Bill is hereby published in accordance with Rule 241(1) (c) of the Rules of the National Assembly.

The Bill provides for:

The amendment of the Restitution of Land Rights Act, 1994, so as to amend the cut-off date for lodging a claim for restitution; to further regulate the appointment, tenure of office, remuneration and the terms and conditions of service of judges of the Land Claims Court; to make further provision for the advertisement of claims; to provide that the lodging of a fraudulent claim shall be an offence; to extend the Ministers powers of delegation; and to provide for matters connected therewith.
