BUREAU OF HERALDRY**APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION OF HERALDIC REPRESENTATIONS AND
OBJECTIONS THERETO****SECTIONS 7, 7A AND 7B OF THE HERALDRY ACT, 1962 (ACT NO. 18 OF 1962)**

The undermentioned bodies and persons have applied in terms of section 7 of the Heraldry Act, 1962 (Act No. 18 of 1962), for the registration of their heraldic representations. Anyone wishing to object to the registration of these heraldic representations on the grounds that such registrations will encroach upon rights to which he or she is legally entitled should do so within one month of the date of publication of this notice upon a form obtainable from the State Herald, Private Bag X236, Pretoria, 0001.

1. APPLICANT: Eureka Varsity (H4/3/1/4135)

ARMS: Per pile inverted embowed Purpure and Sable, over the partition issuant from each flank, a pile conjoined in honour point Argent, each charged with another Tenne, between in chief three coronets flory Or, placed one and two, and in base a double-warded key, the wards in the form of the letters **I** and **E**, and the bow in the form of a triquetra inverted Argent.

MOTTO: EUREKA

2. APPLICANT: The South African Police Service: Presidential Protection Service (H4/3/3/10/29)

BADGE: On an ogress three swords per pall, points inward, there between three crests of the national coat of arms issuant Or, in the centre an inverted triangle Sable charged with an emerald proper, the whole within two fillet annulets there-within the words

PRESIDENTIAL PROTECTION SERVICE in chief and REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA in base, all Or.

3. APPLICANT: Edwin Diem (H4/3/4/883)

CREST: A Demi-lion issuant Or, armed and langued Azure, in his claws a pointed staff placed in bend sinister Argent, flying therefrom a banner Azure, bearing an oak tree branch within a tressure flory Or.

4. APPLICANT: Benjamin Daniel Blom (H4/3/4/977)

ARMS: Azure a king protea Or, seeded Argent; on a chief of the first a cross throughout Or.

CREST: A mural crown Or, with arched buttresses, heightened of an open book Argent, edged Sable, charged with a descending dove Or.

WREATH AND MANTLING: Azure and Or.

MOTTO: BLOM WAAR JY GEPLANT IS

5. APPLICANT: Constant Johann de Villiers Volschenk (H4/3/4/978)

ARMS: Azure, on a chevron Or, between in chief dexter a paschal lamb proper, sinister an eagle with wings displayed Argent, and in base the southern cross consisting of mullets of seven points Argent, a copper flagon proper.

CREST: A Huguenot cross Or, supported in base dexter by a proteaflower Or, seeded Argent, placed in bend, and sinister by another, placed in bend sinister.

WREATH AND MANTLING: Azure semé of mullets of seven points Argent and Or.

MOTTO: MONSTRANT ASTRA VIAM

6. APPLICANT: Alexander Filer (H4/3/4/979)

ARMS: Azure, on a chevron Or, between in chief two trefoils Vert, fimbriated Argent and in base a wolf passant proper, three horse-shoes Sable.

CREST: Within an open laurel wreath Vert, a lyre Or, in the form of two swans' heads and necks addorsed.

WREATH AND MANTLING: Azure and Or.

MOTTO: NEVER GIVE UP

7. APPLICANT: John Cyril Farrant (H4/3/4/980)

ARMS: Per chevron embowed, the peak terminating in a Maltese cross, Gules and Argent, in chief two escallops of the second and in base between two elephant tusks placed in chevron proper a leopard's footprint Gules.

CREST: Issuant from a crest coronet Or, embellished of emeralds proper, heightened of four fleurs-de-lis Or, alternated with as many pearls proper, a mound Gules, thereupon two fish hooks in saltire, perched there upon a red and black bishop bird proper.

WREATH AND MANTLING: Gules and Argent.

MOTTO: DEO GRATIA

8. APPLICANT: William Harley Dartt (H4/3/4/982)

ARMS: Per fess Sable and Azure, on a fess indented Argent, between in chief a mullet Or, between two crescent moons Argent, and in base a leopards face Or, langued Gules, dexter a lion rampant Vert, armed and langued Gules, crowned Or, and sinister a lion rampant Gules, crowned Or, bearing in its paws a mullet of six points Azure.
