BOARD NOTICE 204 OF 2013



Private Security Industry Regulatory Authority

<u>Withdrawn Security Service Providers prohibited from offering security</u> services within the industry.

The Private Security Industry Regulation Act makes provision for the Private Security Industry Regulatory Authority (PSIRA) to effect a withdrawal of registration on a security service provider should there be reasonable grounds to do so or where such a service provider is found to be in contravention of the Act. It further provides for the service provider whose registration is withdrawn to not render any security service during that period.

With the above said, PSIRA effected the withdrawal of security service providers in terms of Section 26(7) of the Private Security Industry Regulation Act prohibited from rendering security services within the industry who;

- Failed to pay annual fees or,
- Voluntarily applied to be withdrawn from rendering services within the industry or,
- Failed to demonstrate minimum infrastructure and capacity requirements
