SMALL CLAIMS COURTS ACT, 1984 (ACT NO. 61 OF 1984)

ESTABLISHMENT OF SMALL CLAIMS COURTS FOR THE AREAS OF VREDENDAL AND VANRHYNSDORP AND WITHDRAWAL OF GOVERNMENT NOTICE NO. 233 10 JANUARY 1992

I, John Harold Jeffery, Deputy Minister of Justice and Constitutional Development, acting under the power delegated to me by the Minister of Justice and Constitutional Development, under section 2 of the Small Claims Courts Act, 1984 (Act No. 61 of 1984), hereby -

- (a) (i) establish a Small Claims Court for the adjudication of claims for the area of Vredendal, consisting of the districts of Vredendal and Clanwilliam;
- (ii) determine Vredendal to be the seat of the said Court; and
- (iii) determine Vredendal and Clanwilliam to be the places in that area for the holding of sessions of the said Court.
- (b) (i) establish a Small Claims Court for the adjudication of claims for the area of Vanrhynsdorp, consisting of the district of Vanrhynsdorp;
- (ii) determine Vanrhynsdorp to be the seat of the said Court; and
- (iii) determine Vanrhynsdorp to be the place in that area for the holding of sessions of the said Court.
- (c) withdraw Government Notice No. 233 of 10 January 1992.

Despite the withdrawal of Government Notice No. 233 of 10 January 1992, any claim emanating from the district of Vanrhynsdorp which has already been instituted in the Small Claims Court of Vredendal prior to the publication of this Government Notice, shall be continued and concluded in the Small Claims Court of Vredendal as if this Government Notice has not been published.
