DEFINING OF PRODUCTION AREA: CAPE PENINSULA

That area situated within the following boundaries:

Starts at a point where the Black River debouches into the Atlantic ocean; thence first generally south and then generally north with the western, southern and eastern coastline of Cape Peninsula to a point where a straight imaginary line, in the vicinity of Carisbrook road joins said coastline with the M4 road; thence further north with said road (M4) to a point where the road intersect the Liesbeek river; thence further north with said river where it joins the Black River; thence further north with last-mentioned river where it debouches into the Atlantic ocean; the beginning mentioned above.
