In terms of section 5(1) of the Remuneration of Public Office Bearers Act, 1998 (Act No. 20 of 1998) (hereafter referred to as "the Act"), I hereby, after consultation with the Premiers concerned and after taking into consideration the matters listed in section 5(1) of the Act, determine that, the salaries and allowances of the Traditional Leaders, Members of National and Provisional Houses of Traditional Leaders shall be as set out in the attached Schedule, with effect from 01 April 2013, subject to the provisions of sections 5(2), 5(4) and 5(5) of the Act and terms and conditions set out herein.
- 2. Proclamation No.6, published in the Government Gazette No. 35745 of 03 October 2012, is hereby repealed.
