This is necessitated by the need to convert an indirect allocation to a direct allocation in terms of Section 21 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2014.

This Gazette therefore updates information that was published in the Division of Revenue Act, 2014.

This notice affects the School Infrastructure Backlogs Grant and the Education Infrastructure Grant,
