Explanatory Memorandum to the Provincial Allocations set out in the Schedules

This *Gazette* is published in terms of the Division of Revenue Act, 2014 (Act No. 10 of 2014), and provides information on adjustments to existing allocations to national departments and provinces in the 2014/15 financial year.

This is necessitated by the need to convert an indirect allocation to a direct allocation in terms of Section 21 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2014.

This *Gazette* therefore updates information that was published in the Division of Revenue Act, 2014.

This notice affects the School Infrastructure Backlogs Grant and the Education Infrastructure Grant,

- a) In compliance with Section 21 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2014 the National Department of Basic Education converts R397.7 million for the School Infrastructure Backlogs Grant into the Education Infrastructure Grant for the Western Cape province.
