

SOUTH AFRICAN SPORTS COMMISSION AMENDMENT ACT, 1999

GENERAL EXPLANATORY NOTE:



(English text signed by the President.) (Assented to 14 April 1999.)

ACT

To amend the South African Sports Commission Act, 1998, so as to provide for the appointment of the Chairperson and Deputy Chairperson of the Commission on a part-time basis; and the appointment of an interim Chairperson; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

E IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:-

Amendment of section 4 of Act 109 of 1998

- 1. Section 4 of the South African Sports Commission Act, 1998, is amended by the substitution for subsection (2) of the following subsection:
 - "(2) (a) The Chairperson and Deputy Chairperson must be appointed by the Minister and will serve on a [full time] part-time basis.
 - (b) The Minister may appoint an interim Chairperson to convene the General Assembly for the purpose of electing the nine members mentioned in subsection (1)(c) who will serve the initial period mentioned in section 5.
 - (c) All other members of the Commission will serve on a part-time basis.".

Short title

2. This Act is called the South African Sports Commission Amendment Act, 1999.
