ACT

To amend the South African Passports and Travel Documents Act, 1994, so as to further regulate the power of the Minister to make regulations; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

B^E [T ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Amendment of section 4 of Act 4 of 1994

1. Section 4 of the South African Passports and Travel Documents Act. 1994, is hereby amended by the deletion in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of the word "and" at 5 the end of subparagraph (ii), the addition of [he word "and" at the end of subparagraph (iii) and the addition of the following subparagraph to the said paragraph:

"(iv) the taking of fingerprints:"

Short title and commencement

2. This Act is called the South African Passports and Travel Documents Amendment I () Act, 1998, and shalt be deemed to have taken effect on I 3 July 1994.
