## ACT

To amend the Gatherings and Demonstrations Act, 1973, so as to replace the short title of the said Act and the definition of the defined area; and to provide for incidental matters.

(Afrikaans text signed by the State President.) (Assented to 3 March 1992.)

**B**<sup>E</sup> IT ENACTED by the State President and the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

#### Substitution of section 4 of Act 52 of 1973

1. The following section is hereby substituted for section 4 of the principal 5 Act:

### "Short title

4. This Act shall be called the Gatherings and Demonstrations  $\underline{in}$  the Vicinity of Parliament Act, 1973.".

### Substitution of Schedule to Act 52 of 1973

10 2. The following Schedule is hereby substituted for the Schedule to the principal Act:

#### "Schedule

The area bounded by the following streets in the City of Cape Town, namely, [Long Street from the point where Long Street, Orange Street and 15 Buitencingel Street meet up to the point where Long Street and Strand Street meet, Strand Street, Buitenkant Street, Mill Street, Annandale Street and Orange Street up to Long Street again Queen Victoria Street from the point where Queen Victoria Street and Museum Avenue meet, up to the point where Queen Victoria Street and Wale Street meet, up to the point where 20 Wale Street and St. George's Street meet, up to the point where St. George's Street and Longmarket Street meet, up to the point where Longmarket Street and Corporation Street meet, up to the point where Corporation Street and Barrack Street meet, up to the point where Barrack Street and Copper Street meet, up to the point where Copper Street and 25 Commercial Street meet, up to the point where Commercial Street and Reumeester Street meet, up to the point where Reumeester Street and Hope Street meet, up to the point where Hope Street and Tuinplein Street meet, up to the point where Tuinplein Street and Vrede Street meet, up to the point where Vrede Street and St. John's Street meet, up to the point 30 where St. John's Street and Gallery Avenue meet, up to the point where GATHERINGS AND DEMONSTRATIONS AMENDMENT ACT, 1992

Gallery Avenue and Government Avenue meet, up to the point where Government Avenue and Museum Avenue meet, up to the point again where Museum Avenue and Queen Victoria Street meet, including the surface of the said streets and the pavement on either side thereof.".

3. This Act shall be called the Gatherings and Demonstrations Amendment Act, 1992.
