ACT

To amend the Correspondence Colleges Act, 1965, so as to extend the term of office of certain members of the Council; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

B^E IT ENACTED by the State President and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Amendment of section 3 of Act 59 of 1965

1. Section 3 of the Correspondence Colleges Act, 1965, is hereby amended by 5 the substitution in subsection (4) for the word "two" of the word "three".

Short title

2. This Act shall be called the Correspondence Colleges Amendment Act (House of Assembly), 1992.
