To amend the Petroleum Products Act, 1977, so as to extend the power of the Minister to make regulations; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

B^E IT ENACTED by the State President and the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Amendment of section 2 of Act 120 of 1977, as amended by section 1 of Act 72 of 1979, section 2 of Act 61 of 1985 and section 2 of Act 68 of 1991

1. Section 2 of the Petroleum Products Act, 1977, is hereby amended-

(a) by the substitution for paragraph (d) of subsection (1) of the following paragraph:

(d) regulate in such manner as he may deem fit, or prohibit, any business practice, method of trading, agreement, arrangement, scheme or understanding which, in the opinion of the 10

Minister, is calculated—

- (i) to influence, or which may have the effect of influencing, directly or indirectly, the purchase or selling price of petroleum [fuel] products at any outlet; or
- (ii) to cause, or which may have the effect of causing, 15 directly or indirectly, an increase in the price referred to in paragraph (c);"; and
 (b) by the substitution for paragraph (e) of subsection (1) of the following

 - regulate in such manner as he may deem fit the supply of any 20 petroleum [fuel] product to any business or undertaking conducted at any outlet, including the imposition of conditions relating to the price at which such product may be sold to such business or undertaking or at such outlet, or prohibit such supply.".
