

BROADCASTING AMENDMENT ACT, 1993

GENERAL EXPLANATORY NOTE:



\mathbf{ACT}

To amend the Broadcasting Act, 1976, so as to increase the membership of the Board of the South African Broadcasting Corporation; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

(English text signed by the State President.)
(Assented to 31 May 1993.)

B^E IT ENACTED by the State President and the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Amendment of section 4 of Act 73 of 1976, as amended by section 2 of Act 61 of 1982

- 1. Section 4 of the Broadcasting Act, 1976, is hereby amended by the substitution for subsection (1) of the following subsection:
 - "(1) The board shall consist of—
 (a) [such number of members not exceeding fifteen but at least five, as the State President may determine from time to time] not less than 21 and not more than 25 members; and
 - (b) the director-general of the corporation referred to in section 9.".

Short title and commencement

2. This Act shall be called the Broadcasting Amendment Act, 1993, and shall come into operation on a date fixed by the State President by proclamation in the Gazette.
