SALE AND SERVICE MATTERS AMENDMENT ACT, 1995

**GENERAL EXPLANATORY NOTE:**

# ACT

To amend the Sale and Service Matters Act, 1964, so as to make provision for the assignment of certain functions and powers to a competent authority within the jurisdiction of the government of a province; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

*(Afrikaans text signed by the President.)  
(Assented to 28 September 1995.)*

**B**E IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

**Insertion of section 2A in Act 25 of 1964**

1. The following section is hereby inserted in the Sale and Service Matters Act, 1964, after section 2:

**“Assignment of functions and powers by Minister**

**2A.** The Minister may by notice in the *Gazette* assign any function assigned to and any power conferred upon the Controller by or under this Act to a competent authority within the jurisdiction of the government of a province.”

**Short title**

2. This Act shall be called the Sale and Service Matters Amendment Act, 1995.
