#### TRANSPORT ADVISORY COUNCIL ABOLITION ACT; 1996

## ACT

To provide for the abolition of the Transport Advisory Council; and for matters connected therewith.

(Afrikaans text signed by the President.) (Assented to 25 March 1996.)

**B**<sup>E</sup> IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

#### **Abolition of Transport Advisory Council**

1. The Transport Advisory Council established by section 2 of the Transport Advisory Council Act, 1987 (Act No. 58 of 1987), is hereby abolished.

2. The Transport Advisory Council Act, 1987 (Act No. 58 of 1987), sections 37 and 38 of the Transport Limited Amendment Act, 1991 (Act No. 52 of 1991), and sections 16 to 25 of the Transport General Amendment Act, 1992 (Act No. 86 of 1992), are hereby repealed.

### Short title and commencement

Repeal of laws

3. This Act shall be called the Transport Advisory Council Abolition Act, 1996, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 April 1995.
