

AMENDMENTS AGREED TO

DEEDS REGISTRIES AMENDMENT BILL [B 102–98]

CLAUSE 1

1. On page 4, from line 1, to omit subsection (1B) and to substitute:

(1B) The Minister may authorise any **[officer in the public service]** <u>person to act temporarily, and either generally or in a particular matter,</u> as assistant registrar of deeds in respect of any deeds registry **[in addition]** <u>additional</u> to any assistant registrar or acting assistant registrar of **[such]** <u>the deeds</u> registry <u>concerned</u>. Such a person must have proven appropriate expertise or the capacity to acquire, within a reasonable time, the ability required to perform the functions of that <u>office</u>, regard being had to the time available and the nature and extent of those functions and the responsibilities of that office.

2. On page 4, from line 8, to omit subsection (2) and to substitute:

(2) No person shall be appointed as chief registrar, registrar, deputy registrar or assistant registrar of deeds after the commencement of "section 2 of the Deeds Registries Amendment Act, 1984 (Act No. 62 of 1984), unless he or she has passed the [diploma iuris examination or an] final examination for the Diploma Iuris, or for any other diploma or a degree, [deemed] recognt zeal by the Minister for the Public Service and Administration to be equivalent thereto, and has [served in the administrative division of the public service in one or more deeds registries for a period of not less than seven years: Provided that this subsection shall not apply with reference to the authorization of any officer under subsection (1A) or (1B) to act as contemplated in the relevant subsection] proven appropriate expertise or the capacity to acquire, within a reasonable time, the ability required to perform the functions of that office, regard being had to the time available and the nature and extent of those functions and the responsibilities of that office.
