#### NEW CLAUSE '

1. That the following be a new Clause:

#### Delegation

23. (1) The Minister may, subject to such conditions as he or she may impose, delegate or assign to the national executive officer, any

officer of the Department or authorised person any power or duty conferred or imposed upon the Minister by or under this Act except the power to make regulations under section 22.

(2) The Minister is not divested of any power or exempted from any duty delegated or assigned as contemplated in subsection (1), and may amend or set aside any decision taken in the exercise of a power or performance of a duty so delegated or assigned.
