# BILL

To provide for the award of certain pension benefits.

 ${f B}^{\rm E}$  IT ENACTED by the Parliament. of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:--

#### Award of certain pension benefits

**1.** There shall be paid to the persons mentioned in the Schedule the pension benefits mentioned therein. 5

#### Short title

2. This Act shall be called the Pensions (Supplementary) Act, 1998.

#### SCHEDULE

- 1. There shall be paid from the National Revenue Fund to John David de Bruin--
  - arrear pension for a period of nine months from 1 September 1996 to 31 March 1997 to the amount of R597,60 per month and from 1 April to 31 May 1997 to the amount of R637,04 per month; and
  - (2) a monthly pension of R637,04 per month, with effect from 1 June 1997.
- 2. There shall be paid from the National Revenue Fund to Mrs Mercia Botha---
  - (1) arrear pension for a period of nine months from 1 September 1996 to 31 March 1997 to the amount of R1 575,00 per month and from 1 April to 31 May 1997 to the amount of R1 678,00 per month; and
  - (2) a monthly pension of R1 678,00 per month, with effect from 1 June 1997.

#### MEMORANDUM ON THE OBJECTS OF THE PENSIONS (SUPPLEMENTARY) BILL, 199\$

1. The objects of the Bill areas set out by the provisions thereof.

2. The State Law Advisers and the Department of Finance are of the opinion that this Bill must be dealt within accordance with section 75 of the Constitution since it contains no provision to which the procedure set out in section 74 or 76 of the Constitution applies.
