# **BILL**

To repeal sections 184A and 184B(1)(a), (b) and (d) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1993; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

 ${f B}^{\rm E}$  IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

# Repeal of sections 184A and 184B(1)(a), (b) and (d) of Act 200 of 1993

**1.** Sections 184A and 184B(1)(*a*), (*b*) and (*d*) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1993, are hereby repealed.

#### Short title and commencement

**2.** This Act is called the Repeal of Volkstaat Council Provisions Act, 2001, and must be regarded as having taken effect on 30 April 2001.

# MEMORANDUM ON THE OBJECTS OF THE REPEAL OF VOLKSTAAT COUNCIL PROVISIONS BILL, 2001

In view of the fact that the Volkstaat Council Act, 1994 (Act No. 30 of 1994), lapsed on 30 April 2001 (by virtue of Proclamation No. R. 25 of 30 March 2001, issued by the President under section 7 of the said Act), it is deemed appropriate to repeal sections 184A and 184B(1)(a), (b) and (d) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1993 (Act No. 200 of 1993) ("the previous Constitution"). In terms of item 20(5)(b) of Schedule 6 to the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996 (Act No. 108 of 1996) ("the Constitution"), sections 184A and 184B(1)(a), (b) and (d) of the previous Constitution continue in force until repealed by an Act of Parliament passed in terms of section 75 of the Constitution.
