BILL

To approve unauthorised expenditure as a direct charge against the National Revenue Fund; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

 ${f B}^{\rm E}$ IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Interpretation

1. In this Act, unless the context indicates otherwise, a word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999), has the meaning assigned to it in that Act.

Approval of unauthorised expenditure

2. The unauthorised expenditure referred to in Schedule 1 in the amount of R32 246 285.72 and in Schedule 2 in the amount of R445 171 384.38, and described in the reports of the National Assembly's Standing Committee on Public Accounts 10 identified in the second column of the respective Schedules, is hereby approved and authorised as a direct charge against the National Revenue Fund.

Recovery of unauthorised expenditure

3. This Act does not detract from or limit any right or obligation to take appropriate steps to recover unauthorised expenditure from a responsible official or responsible 15 former official.

Short title

4. This Act is called the Finance Act, 2008.
