MANDATING PROCEDURES OF PROVINCES BILL [B 8D—2007]

CLAUSE 1

- 1. On page 3, in line 12, after "or" to omit "any other question".

"legislative mandate" means the conferral of authority by a provincial legislature on its provincial delegation to the NCOP to cast a vote on a question contemplated in—

- (c) section 76 of the Constitution; or
- (d) section 78 of the Constitution;

- 5. On page 3, in line 40, after "Bill" to omit "or any other question".

- (a) in section 74(1)(b), (2)(b), (3)(b) and (8) of the Constitution; and
- (b) in section 76 of the Constitution.
