

SOUTH AFRICAN RESERVE BANK ACT, 1989**THE ROTATION OF LANGUAGE USAGE ON CIRCULATION COINS FROM 2002 TO 2011**

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 19 (1) (a) of the South African Reserve Bank Act (Act No. 90 of 1989), I hereby declare -

- a) that the South African circulation coins as set out in Section (b) of the Second Schedule to the said Act, which is being manufactured, and will be issued by virtue of section 16(1) of the said Act, will be legal tender as from 1 January 2002; and
- b) that the rotation of word "South Africa" in all official languages on the obverse of the said coins will be applied as attached to this notice.
